#### **PATIENT HISTORY**

40 year old male patient presented to my office on 8/10/2016 for initial evaluation. Generalized probing depths of 4-9mm and generalized plaque, calculus and inflammation. Radiographs revealed moderate to severe bone loss, localized angular defects and radiographic calculus. Mobility was present on the lower left teeth. He was diagnosed with chronic generalized moderate-to-advanced periodontitis and primary occlusal traumatism. Patient was treatment planned for full mouth LANAP surgery with alternative of traditional periodontal therapy (scaling and root planing, osseous and regenerative surgery).

#### TREATMENT APPROACH

LANAP Treatment was performed in two visits; right side on 12/22/2016 and the left side on 2/13/2017 according to protocol that included occlusal adjustment, occlusal appliance and routine maintenance visits.

#### **RESULTS**

During recent maintenance on 7/3/17, a reevaluation was performed and one radiograph was taken in the lower left to perform an initial check on healing of the angular defects on #19-20. Clinical parameters of decrease in inflammation, decreased mobility, and evidence of radiographic improvement were noted at 5 months post-op LANAP surgery.
